**GENERAL FUNCTION:**

Under direction of an EPA monitor, the SEE enrollee serves as a technical reviewer of documents related to proposed and existing deep well injection projects, including permit applications and land ban petitions. Provides findings and supporting documentation to EPA officials who will be making official Agency decisions. This function involved coordination with outside parties who have submitted applications or petitions as well as state and local governments and others assisting EPA.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- **MUST BE AT LEAST 55 YEAR OF AGE TO MEET REQUIREMENTS OF PL98-313.**
- One or more College degree in geology or closely related disciplines which provide expertise to understand ground water related technical issues.
- Professional registration is a plus.
- Experience in subsurface geology and/or hydrology.
- Experience related to deep well design, construction or evaluation desirable.
- Experience working with Federal, State, or Local Government is a plus.
- Basic computer knowledge and ability to utilize computer programs for technical evaluations.
- Must work well independently and as a member of a team. Excellent verbal and written communication skills.

**POSITION DUTIES:**

- Provides review and technical evaluation of documents submitted in support of permit applications and land ban petition including hydro geologic information, proposed well construction plans, plugging and abandonment plans, and geophysical logs and test procedures.
- Evaluates documents submitted pursuant to the Endangered Species Act.
- Assists administrative processing of permits and petitions through maintaining administrative records, preparing public notices and assisting at public meetings and hearings.
- Provides findings to EPA officials who will be making official Agency decision.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
